Dwell Capital Limited ("Burrow", "Letsburrow", we or us) are committed to protecting and respecting your privacy.

This policy sets out the basis on which any personal information we collect from you, or that you provide to us, will be processed by us. Please read the following carefully to understand our views and practices regarding your personal information and how we will treat it. Information we may collect from you

We may collect and process the following information about you:

- Information you provide to us. You may provide us with information by filling
 in forms on our website(s) or by corresponding with us by phone, e-mail or
 otherwise. This includes information you provide when you register for an
 account or subscribe, contact us through forms, email, live chat or phone
 numbers made available on our website, enter a competition, promotion or
 survey, provide feedback and/or when you report a problem with our website.
 The information you give us may include but is not limited to your name,
 address, contact details, employment details and financial information such
 as banking details, salary, savings, financial commitments and credit history.
- The information you give us may also include details about other persons with whom you may intend to purchase a mortgage.
- Information we collect about you. When you visit our website(s) we may
 automatically collect information about your computer, including your IP
 address, information about your visit, your browsing history, and how you use
 our website(s). This information may be combined with other information you
 provide to us, as described above.
- Information we receive from other sources. With explicit consent from you, we
 may collect information about you from external sources (such as credit
 bureaus). We acknowledge that some of this data may be sensitive personal
 data and will keep this type of sensitive personal data in an appropriately

secure way. We are also working closely with third parties (including, for example, business partners, service providers, advertising networks, analytics providers, and search information providers) and may receive information about you from them. This information may be combined with other information you provide to us, as described above.

How we use your personal information

Sharing your personal information

- any person or legal entity to whom we sell or transfer (or initiate discussions
 with to sell or transfer) our business or any part of it or any of our rights or
 obligations under any agreement we may have with you. If the transfer goes
 ahead, you agree that the purchaser can use your data in the same way as
 us.

When you authorise us to submit a mortgage application on your behalf, the lender will share your information with credit bureaus and Fraud Prevention agencies. They will perform searches which will leave a footprint on your credit file. If you would like to read the full details of how your data may be used, please contact the Lender.

Where we store your personal information

The information that we collect from you may be transferred to, and stored, in storage services, the servers of which may reside in any country. By submitting your information, you agree to this transfer, storing or processing. We will take all steps reasonably necessary to ensure that your data is treated securely and in accordance with this privacy policy.

Where we have given you (or where you have chosen) a password which enables you to access certain parts of our website, you are responsible for keeping this password confidential. We ask you not to share your password with anyone.

Cookies

Our website uses cookies to distinguish you from other users of our website.
